Charity Schafer: Chihuly-Inspired Sculptures

Get inspired by Nebraska’s creepy-crawly critters as students learn about local insects and design their own imaginative cardboard bug sculptures. Blending science and art, this session invites students to explore entomology while crafting unique, three-dimensional creations.
