

## ART DAY CAMP SCHEDULE 2026

### Wednesday July 29<sup>th</sup> 10 am - noon

**Flora Dalton** will lead participants to use air-dry clay to create a personalized self-portrait keychain. By shaping and assembling different clay pieces, each artist will design a unique version of themselves to take home.

### Wednesday July 29<sup>th</sup> 1pm – 3 pm

**Charity Schafer** leads creation of a 2D terrarium that gives the illusion of being a 3D box filled with creatures.

### Thursday July 30<sup>th</sup> 10 am - noon

**Charity Schafer** teaches about optical illusions in art and uses that for students to create their own optical illusion in a straight checkerboard painting that will look wavy to the eye when finished.

### Thursday July 30<sup>th</sup> 1pm – 3 pm

**Charity Schafer** introduces students to fiber arts. Students will learn basic stitching to hand-sew a colorful ice cream cone mini-pillow.

### Friday July 31st 10 am - noon

**Gabrielle Comte & Sarah Juranek** of Bone Creek Art Museum will teach participants to build, cover and decorate books with pages folded in a sculptural accordion style that can stand freely and close like a traditional book.

### Friday July 31st 1pm – 3 pm

**Charity Schafer** directs students by using a variety of materials to create trinket boxes in the shape of birds with movable wings as the lids.

**Flora Dalton** has assisted with many art day camps and took many classes of them as a student. She is now a student at UNL but continues to keep art activities in her life.

The other instructors have college degrees in art and previously taught art day camp sessions for the Butler County Arts Council and others
